Order of the Presiding Judge

Any defendant who has probation terms regarding enrollment and attendance in one or more of the courses stated below is permitted and encouraged to continue with the program if the service provider is able to provide the necessary social distancing to protect the health and safety of the participants.

- All driving under the influence programs described by the Vehicle Code, including but not limited to, §§ 13352(a)(5); 13352(a)(7); 23538(b); 23542(b); 23556(b); and 23562(b)(4).
- All domestic violence classes as described by Penal Code § 1203.097.
- All Child Abuser's Treatment Counseling Program described by Penal Code § 273d(c)(1)-(3).

Pursuant to Emergency Rule of Court, Rule 3, notwithstanding any other law, in order to protect the health and safety of the public, courses may be conducted remotely.

If the service provider is unable to provide the necessary social distancing to protect the health and safety of the participants, or if the defendant does not wish to continue courses at this time, General Order 2020-03 applies.

General Order 2020-03 states in part, "Absent further order of the court, all persons who have been ordered as term and condition of probation to attend any of the classes listed above shall resume enrollment and/or attendance by no later than June 17, 2020."
